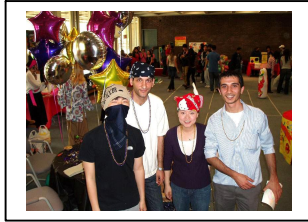


Cultural event of Session IV
